"In terms of bang for buck, I don't think you can do any better," says Blake.


The two new HD units are stickered at 44T – one joining the existing swing lift fleet and the other dedicated to pulling a semi-trailer.

- "Our Fighters run up and down farm races, across horticultural blocks, through vineyards and around subdivisions. Generally they'll be carting 8-10 tonne loads and they don't give us any trouble.
- "One aspect that has really impressed me is the fuel efficiency of the new Fighters. Combined with Fuso's long service intervals, it helps keep running costs low."
